Group: Neanderthals (*Homo sapiens nanderthalensis*), discovered in 1908 in the south of France. Skull very elongated and low, very large capacity: 1 620 cm³. Very strong superciliary arches and receding forehead. Protruding nasal bones salient, wide and tall orbits. Strong mandible with receding chin. Teeth larger than man of today.

Probable age: 35,000

- 45,000 years.
