Site of discovery: Sterkfontein (South Africa). Model of Australopithecus pelvis (species Australopithecus africanus) which is smaller than modern man but which already shows anomalies and morphological features indicating at least temporary bipedal locomotion.

Date of discovery: 1947.

Age: Upper Pliocene, 2.2

- 2.8 million years old.
Mass: 330 g.
Collapsible in 2 parts.
